We ate at La Roma on Easter Sunday 4 April 2010; although we had read the reviews we were a little dubious as we had been before when it was just a pub. We thought it would be the same pub selling pizza. Honestly we couldn't have been more wrong. It was absolutely lovely. We had a great meal, the food was fantastic and the place had a really nice atmosphere.

It still looks like a pub from the outside, but inside just to the right of the bar as you go in is a proper Italian restaurant with tablecloths, candles, bread sticks on the table etc. We had booked a table and were taken

to it straight away. The menu was the same as on the Internet and there were three special starters and three special main courses on the board.

We chose the stuffed mushrooms in filo pastry and tomato garlic bread as starters. Both were very generous sizes, beautifully presented and really delicious. For our main courses we both ordered chicken but they were very different dishes; chicken stuffed with parma ham and cheese and chicken in a lemon sauce. The chicken was well cooked and not 'dry'. We had a big dish of really fresh vegetables with our main courses, these were fine green beans, mange tout, carrots and potatoes. They didn't taste like they had been kept warm for hours and the potatoes were really nice; sort of crushed.

We didn't have much room left, but we decided to share a dessert as the homemade cherry gateau sounded really nice. It was lovely, again a generous portion with a blob of cream, very gooey and soaked in booze!

With a couple of pints of premium Italian lager and water the bill came to under £50 which we thought was really good value.

The service was excellent throughout, although quite busy, they had plenty of staff and there was no waiting.

We would definitely go back.
